2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives have learned a significant era of Chicago broadcast journalism is about to sign off for a final time; and 4 WHEREAS, Viewers of WTTW-TV's Chicago Tonight: The Week in 5 Review have gained a glimpse into the insights of many of 6 7 Chicago's premier journalists over nearly 2,000 broadcasts; 8 and 9 WHEREAS, The program's self-described "traffic cop" for 10 this 40-year endeavor was the always animated moderator Joel 11 Weisman, a quick wit who acquired his skills as reporter, 12 editor, and commentator at the City News Bureau, the Gary Post 13 Tribune, the Chicago American, the Chicago Sun-Times, the 14 Washington Post, and WGN-TV; and 15 Throughout his career, Joel Weisman's 16 journalistic excellence was recognized with multiple awards, 17 including Emmys, Peter Lisagor awards, Jacob Sher awards, and 18 Associated Press awards; he was twice nominated for Pulitzer Prizes for his investigative reporting; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Joel Weisman has developed a well-regarded 21 practice of ensuring his four person panels always represented
